The parents/carers

I/we will:

- Ensure that my child attends school every day, on time from 8:50 a.m. and is suitably equipped, wearing the correct school uniform. (Registers close at 9am)
- Notify the school if my child is absent in accordance with the School's Attendance Policy.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour; please see the school's website to view these.
- Support the schools anti-racist and equal opportunities policies.
- Tell the school at the earliest opportunity about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Refrain from using social media to voice any concerns.
- Park respectfully and safely at all times.
- Support the school in developing my child's understanding of technologies (including mobile phones upper KS2) and the responsibilities that come with being part of the technological world: Digital Wisdom.
- Support my child in opportunities for home learning and with homework when set.
- Attend learning reviews to discuss my child's progress.
- Take advantage of opportunities to be involved with school life.
- Check MCAS / school bag for letters and information.
- Update contact information as and when required via MCAS or directly with office in person or via email.
- Notify the school should you wish your child to bring a mobile phone to school (Year 6).
- Notify the school in writing if you wish your child to walk home from school alone (Upper KS2 only).
- Keep any photographs or videos taken of children at school events or activities for personal use and not shared on social media or WhatsApp.
