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1 - Free 15-hour provision

Every 3 to 4 year old child is entitled to 15 hours of free childcare which would be an am or pm session.

Morning – 08:45am-11:45pm

Afternoon – 12:45pm-3:45pm

Do you want 30 hours provision but are not eligible?

2 - Free 15-hour provision plus paid top-up

If places are available, we can offer paid top-up care (in addition to the free 15 hours) for example:

5 – Eligibility criteria for 30-hour provision

A quick summary of the parents' income eligibility criteria:

Eligible	Not eligible
Parents both working (or sole parent in one parent family)	Only one parent working (if two parent family) * unless in receipt of benefits relating to caring responsibilities, or have a disability and the other parent is working
Each expecting to earn at least 16 hours equivalent on the National Living Wage/National Minimum Wage per week and less than £100,000 per year.	Either parent earning less than 16 hours equivalent or earning £100,000 and more
Self-employed parents and zero hours contracts who meet criteria	Parents who are studying or are in training and do not meet income criteria

One or both parents on maternity, paternity, adoption or statutory sick leave	Either parent is a non-EEA national subject to immigration control with no recourse to public funds
New job or changing hours at work to meet income criteria, you may still apply and declare that you expect to earn at least the minimum amount on average over the next three months
