Dear Parents/Carers,

Please see below the list of lunch time and after school clubs/activities running from W/B 20th April 2026. The three new music clubs and ensembles introduced last term will continue: Recorder Karate and Tuned Percussion Ensemble. Recorder Karate (Years 3–6) is a fun, structured way for children to learn the recorder, earning 'belts' as they progress in their instrumental technique, whilst also strengthening their wider musicianship. The Tuned Percussion Ensemble (Years 3–6) gives children the opportunity to learn how to play the xylophone, metallophone, and glockenspiel within an ensemble context; this club is ideal for children interested in learning to play the piano, as well as experienced pianists.

Please note there will be no clubs running on Monday 4th May Bank Holiday, Thursday 7th May Polling Day, Wednesday 20th May Sports Day, 11th June Summer disco.

After School Clubs run from 3.30pm (please check the schedule of the club for the end time) and sports clubs will require the children to change into their PE kit so please ensure that it is in school. Clubs may be held in the playground so children may need jogging bottoms and sweatshirts if the weather is colder.

All parents must read the code of conduct on page 3 before enrolling their child into a club.

Please look carefully at the club details on pages 2 and 3: if your child is interested in joining a club, please use the My Child at School (MCAS) online payment system to book your child's place. **Bookings will go live at 10am Sunday 29th March and close Monday 13th April at 9am** (book quickly to avoid disappointment).

Choir will operate a rolling membership and therefore if your child is already attending, **you do not** need to re-enroll them.

There is a finite number of children each club can take (for Health and Safety purposes), and this number has been recorded on MCAS. We will do our best to help as many children interested in joining an Activity Club but if the numbers have reached their maximum, please add your name to the waiting list on MCAS.

If clubs are not fully booked and therefore not financially viable, we may have to reconsider the arrangements. We will keep you advised if there is any likelihood of this situation and make a refund if necessary.

Please note that we are unable to offer any refunds if your child doesn't attend for any reason, i.e. school trips or illness.

We continue to review our provisions, and your views are important to us when deciding on our programme, we are always keen to hear your feedback so please email deansfield@compassps.uk.

We are inclusive and wish every child to have the opportunity to experience a school club/activity. Free spaces are available for children who qualify for free school meals, please email the school office using the same address as above. Please contact us if you are not currently registered but would like us to check eligibility.
